



Les Gets Lake Day Out

Walk, Ride & Trail run

Description

A brilliant family day out or a looping 12-14 km walk, ride or trail-run combining mountain views, no steep inclines and an easy bike or walk at altitude using the Pleney gondola lift (which is a hit with the kids!), and you'll enjoy a splash of adventure at the other end after traveling across beautiful mountain tops to **Lac des Écoles** in Les Gets. The lake also offers wild swimming, a beach area, snack bar and cafés, while the lively village of Les Gets is packed with shops, restaurants and family attractions. Return to Morzine by an easy cycle/walk along the main road to Morzine or use Blue Route 24 (a valley floor offroad trail). Or just take the free bus home.

Costs

- **Pleney Gondola:** Free for walkers with Multi Pass; bikes from €5.
You can Buy a 1-way lift pass at Pleney lift station
- **Bus:** free with the Multi Pass (Balad'Aulps Line 1)

Route Information

Distance: 7km to Les Gets (via the Pleney); 6km return to Morzine

🕒 Time: 45–60 mins by bike, around 1hr 45 mins walking (each way)

🚶 Difficulty: Easy riding and walking on tarmac and gravel tracks at altitude. No steep inclines.

🚌 Bus route: Take **Balad'Aulps Line 1** from Morzine Mairie to Les Gets.

Alight at **Place du Pressenage**. Walk through village to the main lift area.

To the right of the chairlifts, take the concrete walking path which goes up towards Lac des Écoles, 5 min walk.

Bike & Walking Route

🚠 Take **Pleney Gondola** to the summit and head right, following the **Blue Route 14/C** across the top of the mountain and through the Les Gets Golf Course, descending to **Lac Écoles**.

For the return from Les Gets:

🚶 Follow the main road, (Rte des Grandes Alpes), back to Morzine for 0.5km after the last roundabout in Les Gets.

🚗 You will pass a garage and Chalet Bluebell. Take the 2nd left turn after Bluebell onto ‘Chemin Route Liberté’ and ‘Nants’.

🚶 Follow the single tarmac road for 0.5km before it turns into a stoney trail, see images below
The track lasts 4km and brings you back onto ‘Rte Grandes Alpes’, but in Morzine.

🌲 Join the road and follow it downhill for approx. 1km to a roundabout, on which is garden centre ‘Delbard’.
Turn right and follow the main road back into Morzine centre

🏠 For Chalets Well & Austin:

From the trail, turn right onto ‘Rte Grandes Alpes’ in Morzine and follow it uphill for 0.5km, past Promocash.
The chalets are on the left.
