Bike, Walk, Run, E-Bike

One of the most beautiful and accessible spots in the Portes du Soleil, **Lac de Montriond** is a stunning mountain lake surrounded by forests and dramatic cliffs. Whether you're looking for a gentle walk, family bike ride, wild swim, paddleboard or kayak session (included with our Active Pack) or simply a relaxing day by the water, the lake makes for a perfect day out.

The lake has grassy picnic areas, cafés and space to relax, whilst the surrounding trails offer excellent walking / cycling. **Travelling by E-Bike is recommended** and makes a great day out.

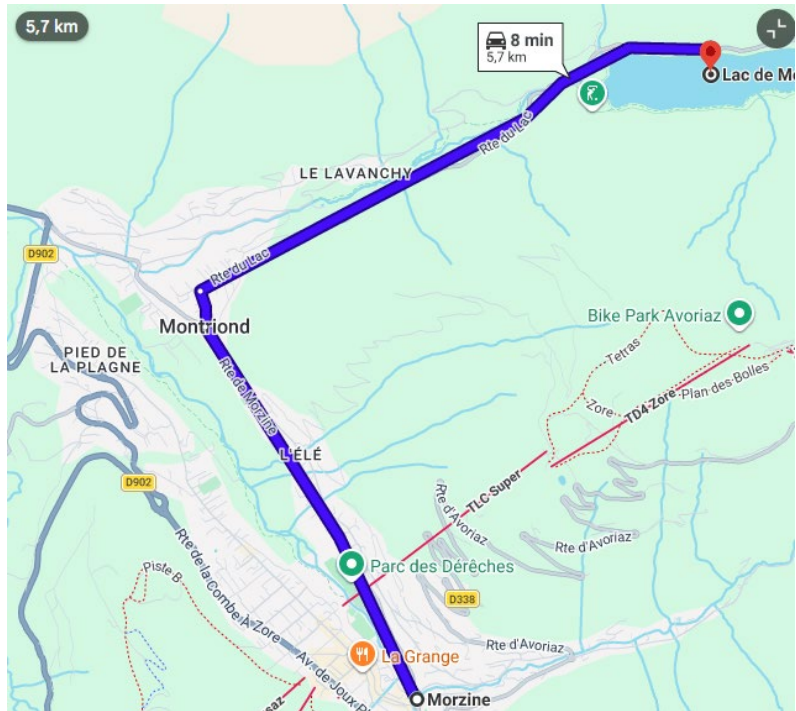
Distance from Morzine: 3km

- Walking: 60+ mins' each way (5.5Km)
- Cycle or E-Bike: 30-40 mins' each way
- Free bus: stops by suspension bridge 'Sunny side' takes 15 mins'

Getting There

By Bike, E-Bike or On Foot

From Morzine centre head to the suspension bridge by Super Morzine gondola. From the 'sunny side' of the bridge (Hermine Blanche & Philibert side), continue on the main road towards Montriond. In Montriond, turn left after the church and the route follows a quieter road. Follow signs for Ardent which climbs gently to the lake through the woods. For cyclists, this is an easy ride suitable for families and less experienced riders.

By Bus: Take the **Balad'Aulps Bus** from Morzine towards Ardent and Montriond. The bus will stop by suspension bridge for Hermine guests.

Extend Your Day: For a longer adventure, continue beyond the lake towards the spectacular Ardent **Waterfalls** (Cascade d'Ardent) or follow the trails up into the **Ardent cable cars** for access to Goat Village and Lindarets. It's a beautiful adventure on an E-Bike.
